After the completion of the FFF pilot, People Serving People modified the program to be more accessible to families by offering all program elements in an “a la carte” manner. This flexibility combined with the waning limitations imposed by COVID-19 has resulted in a tremendous increase in participation and programmatic impact following the pilot period.
